Ans 4 We believe Friends maintain our testimony to a free Gospel Ministry agreeable to our Discipline

Ans 5. With a few exceptions Friends maintain our testimony against the use of all intoxicating liquors and avoid drinking houses and dissuading places of diversion.

Ans 6 The circumstances of those requiring aid are inspected and advice and relief extended when deemed necessary -

Ans 7 - Friends Children of Surlabs aged attend School and when practicable schools under the care of Friends -

Ans 8 Friends maintain a testimony against such Military Services clandestine trade prize funds lotteries and Slavery -

Ans 9 Friends appear to be careful to live within the bounds of their circumstances and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage or engaging in improper speculative trade - We believe they are just in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements

Ans 10 Care is usually taken to deal with offenders reasonably and always in private and in a spirit of meekness and love
