To the Monthly Meeting:

The Trustees refer to the Report of the Treasurer in 1st month last for a financial statement for 1892 of the Various Funds under their Charge.

The School building erected by Thomas Wilson is rented to the Johns Hopkins University for another year at \$1000 a year and the rent is regularly collected and reported in the Central Savings Bank — as part of the income has been used by the Educational Committee of the Monthly Meeting.

The income from the Schafeld Fund has been used to support a night school at Federal Hill. It was reopened last Fourth Month and continued until the middle of the Fourth Month with an average attendance of about 18, at a cost of \$75 for the six months session.

The income from the M. & Warden Fund goes to the Federal Hill at Federal Hill.

The Trustees have decided to invest \$1000 of the accrued interest of the Wilson Fund in one foot security which with the \$2000 already invested in 6% Bonds of the Consolidated Gas Co of Baltimore will make \$3,000 besides the School Building.

There has been no change of note in regard to the Real Estate belonging to the Meeting except that it has been found necessary to remove the iron caps to the Chimneys and Ventilating Stack at the Mission Building Light St. Costing \$151.⁹²
