Report of Friends Association for Christian Work
The Boys Meeting of Friends Federal Hill Mis-
sion was held from 10th month 9th 1892 to
4th Mo 2. 1893 with an average attendance
of 142 scholars. New hymn books were
purchased and as the school was larger
than the previous year, we are encouraged
as to its success.

Bible School
The Friends Bible School, Palau and Monument
was held from 9th mo 25th 1892 to 5th mo 28
1893 with an average attendance of 52. The
amount collected for Foreign Missions was
\$41⁶⁰, a decrease of \$11⁴⁰ for the same period
in the previous year. By an exchange of
books with the Bible School at Fiskerton

many books new to the scholars were put on
the library shelves.

The Temperance Committee report progress.
The Mothers Meeting on Federal Hill has been
very prosperous the past year - The average
attendance was 55 - total 1168, and when we
realize that this means 1168 opportunities of-
fered for the reception of the Gospel, we feel
that the work is important - At the closing
meeting 26 women testified and many
others desired prayers made for them - It is de-
sired that the work shall not be cramped for
the lack of funds.

The Girls Sewing School closed 4th mo 15th 1893
with an attendance of over 200 - The want
of teachers has hindered the work, two or three
often having to look after a hundred girls -
It is hoped that Friends will seriously con-
sider it as the school has accomplished
much good, one former scholar being now
a teacher of sewing in the public school,
another, forewoman of a first rate dress
making establishment and many standing
