The Young Women's Fellowship Union held four meetings, with an average attendance of 25. There were 35 visits paid to sick and shut-in members, and two societies were held -

The Hospitality Committee were on the alert during the year and endeavored to make all strangers feel at home with us. The total expenditures of the Association were \$945⁵⁴, not including the expenses of the Household School and Free Kindergarten which were not under its management -
