4<sup>th</sup> Ans. We believe Friends maintain our testimony to a free Gospel Ministry agreeably to our Discipline -

5<sup>th</sup> Ans. - With a few Exceptions Friends maintain our testimony against the use of all intoxicating liquors and avoid drinking houses and demoralizing places

of Diversions -

6<sup>th</sup> Ans The Circumstances of those requiring aid are inspected and advice and relief extended when deemed necessary -

7<sup>th</sup> Ans Friends Children of Suctaba age attend school and when practicable school under the Care of Friends -

8<sup>th</sup> Ans. - Friends maintain a testimony against such Military services, clandestine trade prize goods lotteries, and Slavery

9<sup>th</sup> Ans Friends appear to be careful to live within the bounds of their Circumstances and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage or engaging in improper speculative trade - We believe that they are just in their dealings and punctual in complying with their engagements
