has been formed which promises helpfulness
to the Young Men of South Baltimore.

The Mothers Meeting and Girls Sewing
School on Federal Hill have been held
regularly and improvement in the Sewing
School has been particularly marked.

A Cooking School of 100 Girls has again
been held this winter at Light Street
Building. The Committee having it in

Charge are working faithfully to have instruction
in Cooking introduced in the Public Schools.
They are not yet able to report the results
of their efforts.

The past Year has been a successful one
in the Eutaw Street Bible School - Increased
interest and attendance both in Adult
and Primary Classes have encouraged
those having the work in Charge.

The Social and Hospitality Committee has
been helpful in promoting sociability
among our own members and welcoming
strangers among us, in the regular meetings
for worship as well as at the times of
our social gatherings.

The Literary Committee has provided
interesting entertainments for the Social
times following the Monthly Business
Meeting of the Association.

The Visiting Committee has fulfilled
its mission by seeing those who are
unable to attend Meeting, thus keeping
up their interest.
