

St Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends for the Eastern and Western Districts held 1st Mo 9th 1896 - The Meeting assembled in joint session. A report was received from Pendersville Preparative Meeting in which it was stated that they did not expect to send representatives to this Meeting.
