The following Communication was received from
the Surviving Executors of our late friend Rebecca
Halward which was accepted.

To Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends
The following is an Extract of the will of R. B. 1890
Halward, dated 22nd August 1890.

"I give and bequeath unto the Baltimore
Monthly Meeting of Friends (or their) for the Eastern
and Western Districts, in unity with the ancient
Yearly Meetings of Friends the sum of forty five
hundred dollars to be applied by it to the following
missions - Three thousand dollars to the Mission
work among the Indians, and five hundred dollars
to the Friends Federal Hill Mission."

When the will was made there was sufficient
assets, not otherwise specifically devised to pay all
cash legacies in full, but subsequent to the
making of the will and before her death
some additional investments were made
and these were specifically devised by a
codicil, thereby creating a deficiency - upon
a final accounting it is ascertained that
