AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMWOOD
Held 12th month, 28th, 1950

There were 23 members present.

The Minutes of the Meeting held 11th month 30th, 1950 were approved as read.

Quarterly Meeting will be held 2nd month 10th, 1951 in Baltimore, and the Nominating Committee was asked to bring forward names of persons to serve as representatives.

Baltimore Quarterly Meeting apportionment of allotments of quotas for 1951 is \$5,612.50, which is 74-5/6% of the total Yearly Meeting Budget of \$7500. Baltimore Monthly Meeting's quota is \$4,223.40. This was referred to the Finance Committee for attention.

The Nominating Committee presented a list of names of persons to serve on standing committees for the year 1951. These names were read, additions made and approved.

The proposed Budget for 1951 was considered. Each item was read, discussed, and the amount of \$10,034.90 was adopted as our goal for the coming year.

The annual meetings of the American Friends Service Committee will be held in Philadelphia 1st month 12th and 13th, 1951 at Friends Meeting House, 15th and Race Streets. Louise Long was asked to be our representative.

The report of the Richmond Conference Continuation Committee was read. This is called a Friends "World Program for Peace". This was referred to our Peace Committee for further action.

Doris Shamleffer spoke on the work being done at the McKim Center and Boys Haven, and suggested that perhaps Friends would appoint delegates from Homewood to serve on the committee. Baltimore Monthly Meeting did not feel that we should take an active part in the project at this time.

The Social Order Committee reports that one family of displaced persons has arrived in Baltimore, and that the people are rapidly adapting themselves to their new surroundings.

The Meeting then concluded.
