AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMEWOOD
Held 6th month, 28th, 1951

There were 12 members present.

The Minutes of the meeting held 5th month, 31st, 1951 were read, corrected, and approved.

Quarterly Meeting was held at Darlington, Md., 6th month, 2nd and all but one of our representatives attended. A verbal report was received from Richard H. T. Carey.

Elizabeth E. Haas wrote that she would like to attend the Oxford, England Conference in 1952 as an alternate. A reply from Edward F. Raiford states that her letter will be considered when the Executive Council meets 10th month 20th next. He also asks if we have names of others to submit, and Baltimore Monthly Meeting desires to add the name of James Hunter to a list already submitted to the Executive Council from our Meeting.

Marlin Dawson reminded us of the importance of having a committee from Homewood to meet with Stony Run Friends, and cooperate in Young Friends Work. The following were appointed:

We would like to record that Miriam E. Brailey and Emily P. Simon were able to be present when Stephen Simon, as a conscientious objector, was brought up for trial. The trial was deferred to 7th month 10th.

James F. Walker, Executive Secretary of American Friends Fellowship Council, wishes to revise the Directory of Friends Meetings in the United States and Canada, last published in 1948. We approve of contributing a small amount toward the expense of this work, and have asked the Finance Committee to forward the sum of \$5.00.

Harold Chance, Secretary of Friends Peace Service, recommended that we purchase a number of pamphlets entitled "A Study of the Teaching of Christ on Peace and War" and that they be placed for distribution. This was referred to the Peace Committee for attention.

Emily P. Simon mentioned that it would be well to forward suggestions to Draft Boards as to possible areas of work for Conscientious Objectors who may be drafted, and this was referred to the Joint Peace Committees for further consideration and action.

It was also approved that a letter be sent to the President and Secretary of State asking that the "Cease Fire" Order be explored as to the possibility of bringing about peace. Emily P. Simon will compose the letter, and it will also be signed by the Clerk.
