

AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMEWOOD
Held 9th month 27th, 1951

Fourteen members were present.

The Minutes of the Meeting held 8th month 30th, 1951 were read and approved.

C. Wayne Carter begins his work as Secretary of Baltimore Monthly Meeting, and expressed his appreciation of the cordial welcome shown.

A request was received from Stony Run meeting that we appoint one person to serve on each of three committees; refreshment, games and wood and to help plan for the Religious Education Picnic at Stony Run School grounds Saturday afternoon 10th month 13th. This was referred to our Religious Education Committee.
