

AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMEWOOD
Held 12th month, 27th, 1951

There were 22 members present.

The Minutes of the Meeting held 11th month, 29th, 1951 were amended and accepted.

Ruthanna Moon mentioned the Church World Service's displaced persons at New Windsor, and this was referred to the Social Order Committee.

G. Cheston Carey, Treasurer, made a report of finances. Of the \$10,034.90 budget for 1951 we received \$9,296.37, showing a deficit to date of \$738.53. Unexpended funds of Committees amount to \$125.65, and the surplus from last year \$155.08. The amount to be raised is therefore \$457.80, less \$200.00 allotted for Special Funds. These Special Funds consist of \$50.00 each for World Committee, Five Years Meeting, Fellowship Council, Committee National Legislation. The Trustees were asked to find an additional \$200.00 to meet this special assignment, with the understanding that if these items are put into the future budgets, they must be raised through subscriptions, and not to come from the Trustees. This was approved.

James Hunter, Chairman of the Finance Committee, presented a budget for 1952. After much discussion, we approved that we should undertake to raise \$10,134.90 the coming year.

The list of names of persons to serve on Standing Committees for 1952 was submitted by the Nominating Committee, and approved. A memorandum of these names is made a part of these Minutes.

The Nominating Committee was asked to review the names of persons on the Ministry and Counsel Committee and bring their report to next Monthly Meeting.

Quarterly Meeting will be held in Baltimore, 2nd month 9th, 1952, and the Nominating Committee was asked to forward names of representatives to attend. C. Wayne Carter, Jean M. Smith and Edna Goodwin will prepare a report of the year's activities, which will be read at Quarterly Meeting.

Gertrude Hodgson passed away 12th month 18th, 1951. A memorial service will be held at Homewood Meeting House 12th month 30th, 1951 at 12:45 P.M.

The Meeting then concluded.
