

AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMEWOOD
Held 6th month 26th, 1952

Twenty-seven members were present.

The Minutes of the Meeting held 5th month 29th were read and approved.

This in addition to the seven who are now planning to go. This creates the need for raising up to \$400.00 more. This was referred to the Finance Committee for attention.

It was suggested that we plan carefully, or much of the inspiration will be lost. Meetings may be planned, and others may wish to give a well rounded picture of the Conference.
