

AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMEWOOD
Held 7th month, 31st, 1952

There were thirteen members present.

The Minutes of the Meeting held 6th month, 26th, 1952 were read, corrected and approved.

The committee reported that the marriage of Ann T. Oliver and John Edward Stemmler was conducted in proper order 6th month, 27th at a meeting for worship at Homewood Meeting House. A letter was read from the parents, at this monthly meeting, expressing their happiness and appreciation.

Lucille Miser reported that the inter-racial Day Nursery, organized by Katherine Whiteside-Taylor and taught by Phyllis Tilley, a graduate of Hampton Institute, is progressing nicely.

The United States Department of Justice acknowledged the letter of 6th month 21st from J. Hollowell Parker, and stated that Stephen Wistar Simon becomes eligible for parole consideration 9th month 27th. Should he apply, the Board will accord him a hearing sometime near that date.

Leonard A. Detweiler, Executive Secretary of Johns Hopkins University writes that 9th month 18th is set aside as "Church Night" for incoming students, and hopes we will participate. Monthly Meeting felt that C. Wayne Carter should be given full opportunity to arrange a suitable program and invite the students to make use of our Meeting House, and also extend an invitation to Goucher College students.

A very full and informative report dated 6th month 15th from Baltimore United Preparative Meeting was read, and approval expressed of their work.

A letter from Wilmington College, Wilmington, Ohio states they have opportunities for students to obtain a college education, and that promising young men could earn virtually the full basic cost of tuition, room and board. A copy of this letter will be sent to Harriet Francis and Edward Raiford, and also will be referred to our Education Committee for consideration.

Allen J. O'Neill, one of our members, will remove to Bethesda, Maryland, and we approve that letters be sent to the Clerks of Florida Avenue and Sandy Spring Meetings, asking them to be on the look out for him and extend a welcome.
