

At Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends - Homewood
Held 12th month, 18th, 1952 by adjournment from
11th month 20th, 1952

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A report received from James Hunter, chairman of the Finance Committee requests that the Trustees be asked for \$200.00 to help balance the Budget of Baltimore Monthly Meeting for 1952. The four conditional \$50.00 each pledges will have to be eliminated, in view of our financial condition this year.

It was approved that an announcement be made on First Day after the Meeting for Worship, at frequent intervals, that the box in the rear is for donations, and that contributions will be gladly accepted. Also, that a card be placed on the box to indicate that the contributions are for certain purposes.

Consideration was then given to the 1953 Budget of \$9,868.13. This amount includes an additional \$10.00 for the new Public Morals Committee. We will attempt to raise this allotment for the coming year.

The Clerk of Newmarket, Ontario, Canada Yearly Meetings has returned the Minute granted James and Margaret Hunter in 6th month, 1951 and acknowledged their visit.

The Nominating Committee was asked to name representatives to Quarterly Meeting, to be held in Baltimore 2nd month, 14th, 1953.

Katherine A. W. Simon consented to prepare a summary of the activities of Baltimore Monthly Meeting for the year 1952, to be forwarded to James Hunter, Clerk.

The State Director of the Selective Service System in a communication dated 12th month 12th states that they cannot recognize Baltimore Monthly Meeting as a non-profit organization authorized to employ a conscientious objector.

The status of Associate Member with Friends was requested by Benjamin and Ann Brown for their son Bradford Thomas Brown, born 11th month 30th, 1952. This was approved.
