A communication received from Guilford College Yearly Meeting acknowledges with much appreciation the visit of Harold Tollefson, and they are returning this Minute accompanied with a message of Christian love from the membership.

Durham Monthly Meeting of Friends, Durham, N. C. write us they desire to build a suitable Meeting House, costing approximately \$20,000, as a memorial to Elbert Russell. After discussion, we decided to send this to our Trustees for consideration, and a copy also to the Executive Committee of Yearly Meeting, to see if funds are available which could be sent for this worthy purpose.

A letter was received from the Maryland Commission on Interracial Problems and Relations, signed by Wm. C. Rogers, Chairman, stating they wish to make a community Self-Survey on Human Relations in Baltimore. They are not asking for funds, but desire that our Meeting send two delegates to attend a Conference. Marlin Dawson, Andrew Simon and Edna Goodwin were appointed a committee to select two delegates and bring their recommendations to Monthly Meeting. We will advise Wm. C. Rogers that the names will be sent later.

Lisa and Lawrence Layton, now residing at Tooele, Utah, desire to enroll their daughter Deborah June Huddleston Layton, born 2nd month 7th, 1953, as an Associate member of Homewood Monthly Meeting. We are happy to grant this request.
