AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING OF FRIENDS - HOMEWOOD
Held 12th month 17th, 1953
by adjournment from 11th mo. 19, 1953

There were 19 members present.

The Minutes of the Meeting held 11th month, 19th, 1953 were read, corrected, and approved.

Howard Tschudy and Marlin D. Dawson spoke of their visit with Ben A. Green, Jr. Meta Tschudy talked with Barbara C. Rayboen. As very favorable comments were reported, Baltimore Monthly Meeting approved that a Meeting be appointed for the marriage of Ben A. Green Jr. and Barbara C. Rayboen, at 3 P.M. 2nd month, 27th, 1953.

The Mid-winter Institute will be held at Pendle Hill 12th month, 30th to 1st month 3rd. The Trustees made available money for three Friends to attend. Brownie and Jeannie Newman have expressed a desire to avail themselves of the opportunity offered.

A communication received from Kathleen F. Brighton, Clerk, states that Margaret T. Inglis was received into membership with Union Congregational Church, Wheatland, Wyoming. Her name will be removed from our list.

A letter from American Section Friends World Committee, Philadelphia, Pa. states that a Conference will be held April 2 to 4, 1954 at Scattergood School, West Branch, Iowa. This was referred to both Social Order and Peace Committees for further attention.

The Minutes of West Baltimore Preparative Meeting for Ninth and Tenth months, were presented.

The public meeting on the question of the sale of beer at the Municipal Stadium will be held 12th month, 28th, 1953. We ask that Margaret Hunter be prepared to speak on behalf of the Public Morals Committee of Homewood Friends, expressing our protest. If she cannot be there, we ask that the Committee find another member who will serve.

The Finance Committee submitted a Budget for 1954 of \$10,131.32, which is an increase of \$263.19 over that of 1953. The amount the Trustees are asked to accept is \$2550.00; also if they will assume an additional \$150.00. There was some discussion as to three items which were marked "goals for 1954". It was decided to hold the matter over until monthly meeting in First month, before accepting the budget as presented.

Quarterly Meeting will be held in Baltimore 2nd month, 13th, 1954 and Jean Mason Smith consented to write a report of Baltimore Monthly Meeting activities for the year 1953, which will be read at next Monthly Meeting, and then forwarded to Quarterly Meeting clerk.

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
