The Clerk read a message from the Thirtieth Yearly Meeting of French Friends, which was passed to Harlin Dawson to be reported to the Baltimore Yearly Meeting (Homewood).

Edna Goodwin read a proposed draft which she had prepared of the Meeting's Annual Report of Meeting Activities to be forwarded to the Quarterly Meeting to be held Second Month 12th., 1955. The draft was approved with additions.

The Clerk read a communication from the Friends Committee on National Legislation regarding the Administration's new conscription plans and asking a contribution from the Meeting to help support the increased costs to be incurred in resisting the measure. Vera Shank reported on the activities of the West Baltimore Preparative Meeting.
