

AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING
OF FRIENDS (HOMewood)

Held: Tenth Month 31, 1957

Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends (Homewood) met at 7:45 P.M., Fifth Day, Tenth Month 31, 1957. There were 22 members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Further consideration of whether meetings on Larger Quaker Concerns should be held on Second Fourth Days of each month, as previously planned, was deferred for consideration at the next Monthly Meeting.

The Clerk of Adelphi Monthly Meeting advised that the membership transfer of Margaret Singleton Baker had been received and that she had been received into membership in that Meeting on Ninth Month 8, 1957.

The annual reports of the Social Order and Ushers Committees were read by the Clerk.

John Sexton, reporting for the Finance Committee, announced that \$1044 of the 1957 budget remained to be raised, and that \$744 would have to be collected from sources other than funds which have been pledged. He said the Committee would send out an appeal letter in the near future.

The Nominating Committee recommended, and the Meeting approved, the following named members to fill vacancies on Committees: House and Grounds Committee; Miriam Green, until 1960; Social Order Committee, Joan Erikson, until 1960, and Matthew Lipa, until 1958; Missions Committee, Helen Silbornagle, until 1959.

The Meeting approved changing the date of Monthly Meeting next month from Eleventh Month 28 to Eleventh Month 21. Dinner will be at 6 P.M., Ministry and Counsel at 7 P.M. and Monthly Meeting at 8 P.M.

The Meeting received a report on the activities of West Baltimore Meeting.

The Clerk read a letter from the Director, Guilford College Choir, concerning a possible concert here, Third Month 28, 1958. The Clerk was asked to reply that the Meeting planned to have Earlham College Choir this winter but would consider having the Guilford Choir next winter.

The Meeting deferred consideration of John Sexton's request for financial assistance in attending the Bad Piermont, Germany, meeting of the Friends World Committee, as a representative of Baltimore Yearly Meeting.
