

AT BALTIMORE MONTHLY MEETING

OF FRIENDS (HOMWOOD)

Held: Twelfth Month 26, 1957

Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends (Homewood) met at 7:20 P.M., Fifth Day, Twelfth Month 26, 1957. There were 15 members present.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved as corrected.

In clarifying the action of the last Monthly Meeting regarding use of the income from the Nicholson Fund as a part of the amount budgeted to be received by the Meeting from the Trustees, it was decided that when the Christian Education Committee requests funds, the Treasurer of the Trustees will be advised what part of the sum is to be used for children and will be able to draw from the Fund's income only that amount. Thus, the purpose of the Fund will be maintained.

The Meeting approved the proposal that Monthly Meeting meet at 7:15 P.M. in the future.

The Clerk read the annual report of the Hospitality Committee.

The Clerk read a letter from Robert and Barbara Greenler requesting transfer of their membership from Homewood Meeting to Milwaukee Monthly Meeting where they are now attending. The Meeting approved and asked the Clerk to notify the Greenlers and the Milwaukee Meeting.

Upon a concern presented by the Social Order Committee, the Meeting, consistent with its opposition to legalized betting of any kind, approved of joining with Stony Run and West Baltimore Meetings in a statement urging the Maryland Legislature to rescind such authority as Anne Arundel County may have to license pari mutual betting on the game of Jai Alai.

The Clerk read a letter from William J. Evans and Georgia L. Johnson asking to be married under the care of the Meeting with Marlin Dawson sharing in the ceremony on Seventh Day, Fifth Month 10, 1958 at 11 A.M. in the Meeting Library. The following committee was appointed to consult with the couple: J. Hollowell Parker, John M. Sexton, Ruth H. Parker and Helen P. Dawson.

The Meeting approved the following nominations of the Executive Committee of members to serve on the Nominating Committee: Patricia Harrison, and Eleanor Richardson, until Twelfth Month, 1958; Ruth H. Parker and John M. Sexton, until Twelfth Month, 1959, and Irma W. Simon, until Twelfth Month, 1960.

The Nominating Committee proposed and the Meeting approved the following members for service on the Finance Committee until 1960: Charles L. Benton, James Hunter, Margaret K. Winslow and Jeanne S. Newman.

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The Nominating Committee was asked to suggest names to the next Monthly Meeting of members to serve as representatives to the Baltimore Quarterly Meeting to be held at Homewood Second Month 8, 1958.

The Meeting approved the 1958 budget which was tentatively adopted at the last meeting with the condition that the Trustees not be called upon to give more than \$6,180. This leaves the budget unbalanced in the amount of \$120 and the Finance Committee was asked to recommend a method of bringing it into balance.

John M. Sexton was appointed to audit the Monthly Meeting Treasurer's books.

After a period of silence, the Meeting concluded at 8:25 o'clock.
