

The committee, appointed in the 3^d month last to receive donations towards the reestablishment of the Library and to have such of the damaged books of the old library repaired as they might judge expedient, have received contributions from within the limits of our own meeting amounting to 100 Volumes and 118 Dollars. And having addressed communications to some Friends of Philadelphia, New York & New Bedford informing them of the loss of our late library by fire and of the object of our appointment, we have received donations from them amounting to 136 Volumes. Also from a Friend of Philadelphia the sum of 25 dollars.

We have paid 38 dollars for retinding 51 Volumes of the old Library and for a Book Case. The Library now consists of about 300 Volumes, and there remains in our hands 100 Dollars to be applied to its enlargement.

As we believe a further addition thereto is desirable and that with suitable care and attention it may be obtained, we are free to propose that a committee be appointed for that purpose and to have the general care of the library. The funds remaining in our hands to be placed at their disposal. And we would recommend that the Subscription book which has been used be kept
