Several of our members, having, within the last year or two, placed their children at Westland, Maryland & other schools; - removals which have taken place since within the limits of this Meeting, and others which are every shortly expected to occur, have in the opinion of the Committee, fastened them on their very delicate conclusion, - that we are not yet at present to meet the views of Yearly in this respect; - which are submitted to the Meeting
