ancient Yearly Meetings of Friends) held the 17th of the
12th Month 1835.

A copy of the Extracts being read at
this time, it was satisfactory to the Meeting, and in
conformity with the directions of the Yearly Meeting, it is
the desire of this Meeting, that each of our Monthly Meetings
shall open subscriptions to raise Funds, for the purpose
of assisting to carry into effect the plan of operations
reported by the Committee on Indian Concerns, and agreed to
(with some exception) by our late Yearly Meeting, for the
benefit of the Shawnee Indians, and the instruction of their
Children: and it is requested that the amount collected be
forwarded in the 5th or 6th Month next, to Joseph King
Treasurer of the Committee on Indian Concerns.
