Elizabeth Gillingham not being present her appointment was left for another month.

Hannah Worthington, Sarah Brooks, and Martha Carey were appointed to attend the Quarterly Meeting as our representatives and report.

The following minute from mens meeting being read and united with, the clerk was directed to forward it in our report to the ensuing Quarterly Meeting, viz. "This meeting taking into consideration the present arrangement

of holding our monthly meeting, from which circumstance our regular midweek meeting on fifth day is omitted in the monthly meeting week; it was thought that an advantage would result from a change in the time of holding it, and that it would be more convenient for friends to hold their monthly meeting as the preparative meeting is now held, at the close of our regular midweek meeting on fifth day. Friends generally uniting in the proposed change, the clerk was directed to forward a copy of this minute in our report to the Quarterly Meeting."

Sarah Webster, Emily Hopkins, Deborah Hopkins and Pisalla Morgan were named to collect for the monthly meeting stock, and place the money in the hands of Ann Waterhouse, who was appointed treasurer.

Grace Hopkins and Sarah Webster were added to the committee who have the care of the poor.

The meeting adjourned.
