The committee appointed to collect for the monthly meeting stock, reported that they had collected 32 dollars and 50 cents, which have been placed in the hands of the treasurer.

The proposition from mens meetings relative to recording the minutes was united with, which is as follows.

It having been suggested that much inconvenience and difficulty might be obviated, by a change in the mode of recording our minutes, by directing the clerks, subsequently to each Monthly Meeting to transfer from the Blotter the minutes and proceedings of the last into the Record Book, and at the next succeeding Monthly Meeting the minutes be read from the Record, whereby the meeting will from time to time be put in possession of its proceedings as they stand on Record. The proposition was united with, and the clerks were directed to proceed accordingly.

The meeting adjourned.

At Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Women Friends for the Eastern and Western districts, (in unity with the ancient Yearly Meetings of friends) held the 5th of the 2nd month 1829.

The preparative meeting informed that Margaret Balderson, and Hannah Green, were appointed to attend the Monthly Meeting as representatives; who were present.

Men friends informed this meeting, that a proposition had been made to change the time of holding the select preparative meeting to the close of the meeting for worship.
