

At Baltimore monthly meeting of women friends (in unity with the ancient yearly meetings of friends) held the 4th of 1st mo 1830

Two of the representatives were present

A certificate was received from Motherfield monthly meeting, held at Motherfield dated 6th of 11th mo 1829. for Susannah Needles a minister in good esteem, also one for Rachel Matthews from same meeting bearing same date, ^{both of} which were read and accepted

The committee appointed to visit Margaret Evans, informed that the indisposition of one of their number prevented them from being in readiness to report. They were continued with the addition of Hannah Talbot

The committee appointed to visit Martha Evans, reported that they had attended thereto and were free that her request should be granted which being considered was united with, and the same friends were continued to inform her thereof

A certificate for Margaret W Robertson was produced approved and directed to be signed.

The committee in Eliza B Duncans case were continued

The representatives to the Quarterly meeting reported, that they had attended to their appointment

The committee appointed ~~and~~ ^{and} Miss Indian spring ~~and~~ ^{and} the meeting not being in readiness to report were continued to that service.

The committee in Elizabeth Gillinghams case reported that they had ^{found} nothing to prevent her procedure in marriage with Thomas Worthington. But in consequence of the monthly meetings of Seneca and Baltimore coming on the same day a certificate for Thomas Worthington could not be produced from that meeting. The subject was therefore ~~deferred~~ ^{referred} to next month.

Ann Waterhouse, Sarah Webster, Anna Roberts & Hannah Talbot were appointed to prepare for the approbation of next meeting, friends to serve as clerks the ensuing year

Then adjourned
