Burlington Monthly Meeting, reported that
the service had been performed, and that she
had received it affectionately. The Clerk was

directed to furnish that Meeting with a copy of
this minute signed on behalf of this Meeting.

The friends in Margaret Hnuls case reported
that they had visited her and found her affectionate
but not disposed to condemn the steps she had taken
and that they believed further labour with her
would be unavailing. with which the meeting united
and continued the same friends to join with
men friends in preparing a testimony of
disownment against her if they should find no cause to
forbear.

Baltimore prepa-
-rative Meeting informed that Sarah Webster
had united herself to the Methodist society
Dorothy Hopkins and Ann Waterhouse were
appointed to visit her and report their care

Philina Matthews (formerly Lamb)
has had her Marriage accomplished contrary
to the Established order of our society, and

Monthly Meeting. Mary Robinson and
Margaret Balderson are appointed to write
to that Meeting requesting it to treat with
her on our behalf and inform us of the result of their
care.
