The following communication ^{received} from Middletown Monthly Meeting in the case of Ann Pugh was read and united with Hannah Talbot and Hannah Mitchel were appointed in conjunction with men Friends to prepare a testimony of disownment against her if they should find no cause to forbear and produce it at next meeting

A communication from your Meeting dated the 5th of the 11th Month 1824 Addressed to Middletown Monthly Meeting, requesting it to treat with Ann Pugh (formerly Peck) on the charges received from this Meeting, has been received; and in conformity with the request a committee of Women Friends was appointed who reported they had treated with her; and she was not disposed to condemn her deviation.

The Clerk was directed to give Baltimore Monthly Meeting ^{that} information.
