ny of disownment against Anna Hopkins pro-
duced the following one, which was read and
approved, the same friends were continued

to send her a copy thereof and inform her of her
right of appeal

Ann Hopkins (late Chandle)
has so far deviated from the good order of our
religious society as to have her Marriage accomplish-
ed contrary thereto, and having been visited
without manifesting a disposition to acknowledge
her deviation, We therefore disown her from
being any longer a member
