She has neglected the attendance of our religious Meetings and is in connection with Meetings not acknowledged by our Yearly Meeting, thus identifying herself with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles, she having been visited and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation, we disown her from membership with us.
