

4th Ans^r Our testimony against the unnecessary use of Spirituous liquors is maintained as far as appears, and we know of none frequenting taverns, and places of Diversion, Moderation and Temperance observed by most friends.

5th Ans^r The necessities of the poor and those who may appear likely to require aid, are inspected and some relief afforded. No children amongst us require the aid of friends.

6th Ans^r Friends are careful to maintain their testimony against the several particulars of this query.

7th Ans^r Friends are concerned to live within the bounds of their circumstances, and to avoid involving themselves in business beyond their ability to manage, and to observe justice and punctuality in complying with their engagements.

8th Ans^r We believe friends are careful to bear their testimony against slavery, and those under their direction suitably provided for, as far as appears some attention paid to their school learning.

9th Ans^r Care is taken to deal with offenders as the query directs, as far as practicable.

12th Ans^r Some encouragement given to teachers in membership with us.

The friends appointed to deliver the testimonies of disownment offered to our last Monthly Meeting reported they had performed the service assigned them.

Mary Brown has so far departed from the good order of our religious society as to associate herself with those who have separated from communion with the Ancient Society of friends, She has neglected the attendance of our religious meetings and is in connection with meetings not acknowledged by Yearly Meeting. Thus identifying herself with the seceders and evidencing unity with their principles. Having been visited and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation; We therefore disown her from membership with us!
