The same friends were continued, to deliver them to each one respectively, and report their care to next meeting.

Hannah Churchman has so far departed from the good order of our religious society as to associate herself with those who have separated from communion with the ancient Society of Friends. She has neglected the attendance of our religious meetings, and is in connection with meetings not acknowledged by our yearly Meeting, thus identifying

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herself with the seceders and evincing unity with their principles, having been visited and manifesting no disposition to acknowledge her deviation. We therefore disown her from membership with us.
