The friends appointed to prepare a certificate for Priscilla Jones produced one which was read approved and directed to be signed.

The friends appointed informed that Middletown Monthly Meeting had been addressed in the case of Ann Dukehart

The committee appointed to unite with men friends in preparing a certificate for John and Ann Dukeharts children produced one which was read approved and directed to be signed.

The friends appointed to unite with men friends in preparing a testimony against Eliza McCoy produced the following one which was read approved and directed to be signed. they are continued to furnish her with a copy thereof and report
