1st Answer

First day morning meetings have been mostly attended by the greater part of our members - other meetings sometimes small - unbecoming behavior generally guarded against and the hour nearly observed

2nd Answer

We believe friends are generally careful to maintain love towards each other becoming an Christian profession - also to discourage backbiting and detraction

No differences apparent

9th Answer

Endeavors are used to deal with offenders nearly as the queries direct.

The committee appointed to join men friends in preparing a testimony of disavowment against Deborah Robinson produced the following which was approved and the same friends were continued to have her a copy thereof and inform her of her right of appeal
