

be false. It is with deep humiliation that I have since, and do now realize the gross immorality and wrongfulness of this conduct, and I do most fully and freely condemn the same.

This much only I desire to say on my own behalf, that no part of the property which came into my hands from Anna Read or her estate is now in my possession or control, and that I have not at any time concealed any part thereof from the present administrators of her estate, all of her estate remaining in my hands at the time of their appointment having been turned into Court, and all my own property (being myself in an insolvent condition) having been assigned and delivered to a Trustee for the benefit of my creditors.

It is my earnest purpose from this time forth to conform my conduct to the standard of truth and right, and believing fully in the principles of the Society of Friends, it is my hope that the foregoing acknowledgment will be accepted and

that I may be retained as a member of Baltimore Monthly Meeting.
