John C. Thomas reported that a night school for primary scholars had been successfully conducted since the first of the year at Friends Federal Hill Mission by Ida O'Connor, at a cost of \$2⁰⁰ to 3⁰⁰ per week for salary of teacher, according to the number of scholars, & an expenditure of \$13.⁸⁷ for books, maps, table, etc. The report was satisfactory & Jos. P. Elliott & Mrs. C. Thomas were appointed to have charge of the management of the school, & to fix the proper time of closing for the summer.

Ida O'Connor having shown a special aptitude for teaching, both in the night school & in the Free Kindergarten at the Mission, it was decided to grant \$50.- a year for 2 years from the Schofield Fund towards the expense of training

her as a kindergarten teacher, if practicable. Application having been made to this Board for permission to establish a cooking school in the Mission building, it was decided to grant the use of the attic for that purpose, & to recommend the Monthly Meeting to finish off a room there for it.

The repairs made to the different buildings by order of the Secretary during the past year, were approved.
