At a called meeting of the Trustees of Balt. Monthly Meeting of Friends held 2nd Mo. 25th 1897, present Sas. Carey Thomas, Jesse Lyson, Jos. P. Elliott, Sas. Carey, Jr., & Jno. C. Thomas.

It was decided to rebuild the fence on the south side of the Mission premises on Light st. & to collect half of the cost from the owners of adjoining properties.

\$25.⁰⁰ of the income from the Schofield Fund heretofore appropriated to the educational work of the Young Mens' League was transferred with its consent to the educational work of

the Girls' Fellowship Club, Light st.

The following minute of the Monthly Meeting was directed to be entered on our minutes, as authority for the alterations & improvements which are now being made in the school building adjoining the meeting house, & in the disposition of accrued income from the Wilson Fund.

"at Balt. Monthly Meeting of Friends held 1st Mo. 7th 1897, The School Committee were authorized to make the disposition of the building suggested in their report (adapting it for the use of the Bible School, & for the various other religious & philanthropic work which engages the attention of our members) and to use such portion as may be necessary of the accrued rentals & the entire interest accruing from the invested balance for the purposes named in the report."
