It was decided to ask the Kindergarten Association for a contribution of \$50.- towards the cost of heating & janitor-service of room which they now occupy at Light street Mission building.

Thomas, secretary, also, Jesse Tyson, & Miles White Jr, the latter having been appointed by the Monthly Meeting to fill the vacancy in this Board occasioned by the death of Dr Jas. Carey Thomas.

It was decided to accept an offer of Mary McCullough to pay \$1000.- towards renovating the meeting house corner of Cutaw & Monument sts, and Jesse Tyson, Miles White Jr, & John C. Thomas were appointed to have the improvements made & to raise by subscription the additional sum needed.
