The following minute of the Monthly Mtg
was directed to be recorded on our minutes,
"at Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends
(men) held 10th mo. 6th 1898.

The committee appointed to nominate
a suitable man Friend to fill the
vacancy in the board of Trustees of

the Meeting proposed the name of
W^m L. Elliott, who, being acceptable
to the meeting, was unanimously
elected Trustee of Balt. Monthly Mtg.

The committee on renovating the meeting
house reported that the work had been
finished to satisfaction at a cost
of \$1448.⁹² of which \$1084.⁷⁵ had been furnished
by our Friend Mary McCullough, and
the balance by subscriptions from
other members. The committee
was released.

In view of an attempt to secure a
license for the sale of intoxicating
liquors nearly opposite the meeting
house, it was decided to enter a
protest against it, signed by all the
Trustees.
