"Owing to the overwhelming amount of work and the confusion occasioned by the great fire, no report was prepared by the Trustees last year.

Francis White, the President of the Board, died during the year, and Wm L. Elliott has been elected to that position. The vacancy in the Board has been filled by the election of Richard J. White.

The legacy of \$5000.- from our friend Francis White has been invested as follows viz. \$3000.- on mortgage at 5% on the house & lot No. 225 St Paul st, and \$2000.- on mortgage on the house & lot No. 215 Oakdale Road. The legacy of \$487.⁵⁰ from our friend J. Fussell Martenet is deposited for the present in the Provident Savings Bank. There has been no other change in investments.

Friends Institute building was rented as a temporary accommodation to Ladler's Business College at the rate of \$2000.- per annum. It will be vacated on the 1st July next &

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it is proposed to use so much of the rent received as may be needed for the improvement of the building.

At a meeting of the Trustees of Balt. Monthly Meeting of Friends. (Orthodox) held 10th mo. 13th 1905, present Miles White Jr, Jas Carey Jr, Richd J. White & John C. Thomas Secty; there being no President, owing to the death of our friend Wm L. Elliott, Jas Carey Jr was elected temporary President, & was authorized to sign an agreement with the Johns Hopkins University, to remove such drain pipe as it may allow us to connect with its sewer, upon receiving ten days notice to do so, there being no charge for our use of the sewer.

The Monthly Meeting having referred to us together with the Treasurers, the investment of \$4000.- received from life insurance on Wm P. Dawson deceased, the purchase of \$2000.- in City Rapid Transit 5%
