We have invested the \$4000 returned to the meeting from the life insurance of Thos. L. Dawson in the purchase of \$2000 Twin City Rapid Transit 5% bonds, and \$2000 United Ry and Electric Co. ^{of Balt.} 4% bonds. We have received and have on deposit at 3% interest \$450 - net proceeds of the sale of Bendersville Meeting House, \$100 - of the amount of the sale price having been paid to the heirs of Dr. Mumma, who gave the land.
