On motion the Treasurer was directed to invest the proceeds in two \$500 bonds of the Southern Pacific Co - Cent. Pacific Coll 4th.

The minute authorizing the sale of Atlantic Coast Line RR certificates of indebtedness was changed so as to read "exchange for Convertible Bonds" instead of "sell" -

It was agreed to approve of the appropriation of \$100 - to the Light St. Free Kindergarten and \$100 - to the Gymnasium Committee of the Social Service Committee if authorized by the Monthly Meeting, from the income of the Francis White Fund.

The Young Women's Christian Association having under consideration a plan for work for girls in the vicinity of the Light St. Meeting house, it was agreed that \$2.00 per night would be a suitable charge for the use of the rear room and the gymnasium two nights in the week.

The room used by the Kindergarten and Infant Classes being in need of repair it was agreed to
