

At a meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held, 12 mo. 2^d, 1918, there were present John B. Thomas, President, Miles White Jr., Richard J. White, John N. Parker and John R. Bay, Secretary.

The following appropriations, referred to the Trustees by the Monthly Meeting are approved: \$80.00 for instructor in physical culture at Light St. last season; \$100 for Light St. Free Kindergarten for this year, and \$500- for the use of special committee at Light St. this season, all to be taken from the income of the Fancis White Fund.

The Treasurer was authorized to pay for extra labor on the Light St. building during the winter as needed by Mrs. Day to the amount of \$10- per month if needed.

The Treasurer was directed to add to the Meeting House Building Fund the net amount of the income from that fund proceeding from the loan or investment of the money received from the sale of the institute property after paying

any costs or charges connected with the sale of the old or carrying of the new property
