

At a meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held Jan. 7th 1919 there were present John B. Thomas, President, Miles White Jr., John N. Parker, and John R. Bary, Secy.

The President was authorized to have the ceiling on the bridge leading from the N.E. door repaired, and to have the outside front doors varnished.

Also to have the exterior wood work of the Light St building painted.

It was agreed to fix the wages of the Janitor at Light St at \$49 per month for eight months of the Winter season, and \$40 per month for the other four months, in addition to house rent.

No affair, subject to action by the Monthly Meeting of appropriating \$50 from the income of the Francis White Fund for work at Light St. and \$100 from the same fund for Light St. Frank Kindergarten.

In view of the poor quality of gas now furnished the President was authorized to have electric lighting installed in the centre of the large meeting room at Eutaw and Monument Sts.

He was also authorized to purchase a new furnace to replace a worn out one at Light St.
