

At a meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held 1st month 28th 1921 - there were present all the members -

An appropriation of \$100 to the Light St Free Kindergarten from the Francis White Fund was approved.

An offer having been received for the Meeting House property of \$3000 - and a broker having expressed a desire to offer a higher price later the Board adjourned to the 31st without action.

At a meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held 1st month 31st 1921 - all the members being present, and no higher offer than \$3000 being received, it was decided to hold the property at \$3500 - and the President was directed to place a sign upon the premises offering it for sale -

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At a meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held second month second, 1921, the President reported that Thor B. Hall, acting for W. E. Bonebrake & Co. had offered \$32500 for the Meeting House property at Antawn Monument Sts, and tendered \$1000 as advance payment on account - It was unanimously decided, all the members being present, to accept the offer on condition that the net return to the meeting be \$32,000 - and the President was authorized to sign a contract of sale reserving the walnut rail and trimmings around the platform in the main room - possession to be given by May first -
