

At a meeting of the Trustees of Balto Monthly Meeting held April 15th 1921. there were present the President, Miles White Jr., Jas Carey Jr., John N. Parker and John R. Carey.

After discussion of plans for storing the furniture and other contents of the Eutaw St Meeting House pending completion of the new building to be erected on the Charles St lot it was decided to have the carpets, rugs and cushions cleaned and stored, and to move the other things to Light St to be stored in the gymnasium.

The President was authorized to arrange for moving and the Treasurer of the Building Fund directed to pay the expense of same.

An appropriation of \$500 from the income of the Francis White Fund for work at Light St made by the Monthly Meeting was approved.

At a meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held April 20th 1921, present the President Miles White Jr., Jas Carey Jr., John N. Parker and John R. Carey.

Terms of payment for the property at Eutaw and Monument Sts were agreed upon with H. E. Houch & Co., as follows -

Nine thousand dollars to be paid upon delivery of deed May first, two thousand dollars to be paid August first and twelve thousand five hundred dollars on September first, the last two payments to be secured by mortgage and to bear interest at six percent. from May first.

The officers were directed to execute the necessary papers in connection with the transfer of title.
