

At a called meeting of the Trustees of
 Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends held
 First month 9th, 1922, there were present John
 C. Thomas, President, Miles White Jr., Jas. Carey Jr.,
 John N. Barker and John Albary, Secretary.

The Treasurer, Miles White Jr., was authorized
 to borrow \$10,000 to be used in making payment
 to the contractor on account of cost of the new
 Meeting house on N. Charles St., pledging as
 collateral security bonds held by the Trustees
 which are not a part of funds given for special
 uses.

The President was directed to apply for a loan of
 not exceeding \$5000 to be secured by mortgage on
 the Meeting house property on Charles St., the
 proceeds to be applied to the cost of the building -
 application to be made to the Central Savings
 Bank and loan to be made as of February 10th.

An appropriation of \$100. from the income
 of the Francis White Fund to the Light St Free
 Kindergarten was approved.
