

At a called meeting of the Trustees of Baltimore Monthly Meeting held March 8th, 1928, all the members were present -

The Secretary reported upon an urgent request for the use of the dining room at Homewood received from a committee arranging for a testimonial dinner to Oswald Garrison Villard, difficulties in arranging this having arisen on account of possible attendance of colored people. This request was refused, in spite of our objection to racial prejudice, because of the understanding that the use of the building should be confined to purposes distinctly in connection with religion, philanthropy or education.

After discussion of the complications involved in the present form of accounting for invested funds held by the Treasurer it was agreed that all such investments shall hereafter be carried in one general fund, the aggregate income from the same to be divided among the different trusts in proportion to the amount each shall have contributed to the total capital fund on the basis of the original legacy or gift -

The corporate name of the Monthly Meeting having been changed to "Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends, Homewood" - the attached seal is adopted as the seal of the same.

The Treasurer was directed to renew \$4000 of insurance upon the Howard Meeting House -
