RELEASE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That I, G. Alfin Eppley, of the City of Baltimore, and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have released and discharged, and do hereby for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, release and discharge the Baltimore Monthly Meeting of Friends (Homewood) a corporation of the State of Maryland, its successors and assigns, its agents, employees, committees, and members, of and from any and all causes of action, claims and demands whatsoever, arising out of the occupancy and rental of rooms in the premises known as 23 East 21st Street, Baltimore, Maryland, to one Naomi T. Price during the years 1928 and 1929, or of any cause, matter or thing whatsoever.

Provided, however, that this release shall not release the said Naomi T. Price from my claim for rent due by her for said occupancy, but I agree to give her credit for the payment of the above named sum in any and all claims for rent that I may have or make against the said Naomi T. Price.
