The Finance Committee of Baltimore Monthly Meeting met at the home of Ella Cowman.

Miss White, Jr., Alfred Townsend, Lindley E. Parker, G. Cheston Carey and Margaret J. Carey were present. Margaret J. Carey was made Secretary for the day, in the absence of Louis Mueller. After a time of quiet, the chairman reported:

Total pledges to date ..	50 out of 127

In prospect, not pledged .. \$1500 or \$2000.

The Committee decided to change the proportions of the unallocated funds to 50% for General Expenses 25% for United Budget. 25% to Evangelistic & Church Extension Committee.

Ella Cowman read the draft of a report to be sent to the Monthly Meeting, which was approved.

Alfred Townsend was asked to write a letter to be sent to those who have not pledged, and if this does not bring results - those failing to answer will be apportioned by Ella Cowman to the members of the Committee to visit.

The question of paying for rug bought by House and Grounds Committee was brought up.
